Modified Teacher's Drooling Scale (mTDS)



The mTDS is a 9-point scoring system measured by parents/carers to provide an indication of the severity of drooling.

Tick the option which applies to your child: 1. Dry, never drools 2. Mild: only the lips are wet; occasionally 3. Mild: only the lips are wet; frequently 4. Moderate: wet on the lips and chin; occasionally 5. Moderate: wet on the lips and chin; frequently 6. Severe: drools to the extent that clothing becomes damp: occasionally 7. Severe: drools to the extent that clothing becomes damp; frequently 8. Profuse: clothing, hands, tray and objects become wet: occasionally 9. Profuse: clothing, hands, tray and objects become wet: frequently
