

Modified Teacher's Drooling Scale (mTDS)

The mTDS is a 9-point scoring system measured by parents/carers to provide an indication of the severity of drooling.

Tick the option which applies to your child:

- 1. Dry, never drools
- 2. Mild: only the lips are wet; occasionally
- 3. Mild: only the lips are wet; frequently
- 4. Moderate: wet on the lips and chin; occasionally
- 5. Moderate: wet on the lips and chin; frequently
- 6. Severe: drools to the extent that clothing becomes damp; occasionally
- 7. Severe: drools to the extent that clothing becomes damp; frequently
- 8. Profuse: clothing, hands, tray and objects become wet; occasionally
- 9. Profuse: clothing, hands, tray and objects become wet; frequently
